

Florida-Friendly Landscaping™ Outstanding FFL Community

Recognizes: This award recognizes communities that have adopted environmentally sound landscape, irrigation, pond maintenance, and management policies that include Florida-Friendly Landscaping™ principles. The jury will consider the design, installation, and maintenance of the landscape based upon the nine Florida-Friendly Landscaping™ principles.

Typical Entries Include: Residential communities that have modified their landscape to become a Florida-Friendly landscape. Nominees may self-submit or may be nominated by others.

 - Please state or describe the outreach activities that were part of the development of your program and methods used to create support among property owners, if applicable.
 - Discuss any challenges you faced in promoting program adoption to your board and/or residents.

- **Scope of Project**
 - Which of the Florida-Friendly Landscaping™ Program's nine principles have been adopted? (see [nine principles attachment](#)).
 - Have you made improvements to your stormwater ponds, if applicable? (see [stormwater attachment](#)).
 - Please include any additional information you consider relevant to the topic.
