 - Download the PowerPoint Show files to the computer you are using rather than playing the files via internet, wireless or network connections.
 - O You may need to click the slide to start the video playing.
 - o Workarounds if the video still doesn't play or you see a "codec not found" error:
 - Open Windows Media Player before opening the PowerPoint (this can help Windows "find" the codec – you don't have to keep it open)
 - Copy the PowerPoint files to a USB flash drive and play from there.
 - o If the workarounds don't work, make sure all updates for Windows and Media Player have been installed on the computer.
