Subject: FDACS CEU Procedures and IST materials online

Changes to FDACS CEU site are complete; co-providers can now add classes

- New site address: <https://ceu.freshfromflorida.com>
- Logging in:
 - Use your email and a PIN to log in on the new site: your login from the old site will not work.
 - You must activate your account by clicking the activation link in the PIN email.
- Adding classes:
 - All GI-BMP classes must be entered under the approved statewide program ID s – **do not add your own program for GI-BMP. The 2015 program numbers are:**
ENGLISH: 19490 SPANISH: 19567 CREOLE: 18316
 - To find the program, click "**All Approved Programs**" and search for the program by ID, Provider (Don Rainey) or co-provider (you).
 - **Click "Add a Class" link beside the program - NOT on the left sidebar.**
 - If you are not listed as a co-provider on the program ID, contact the [GI-BMP state office](#) to be added.
- Printing Record of Attendance:
 - Click "Manage Attendance" and "Print Sheet w/o Attendee" for your class.
Note: your browser must allow pop-ups for the site.
- **If you added classes before the March 30 site change, your classes are still listed under the previous program ID and you have been added as a co-provider for that program.** If you have trouble accessing your classes, you can contact Jen Marvin at the GI-BMP State Office for assistance.
